Telegrafik and Vivago combine their innovations to more effectively protect nursing home residents



The benefits of this complete and innovative device for nursing homes are confirmed after installation in a second establishment.

The watch created by VIVAGO and Otono-me Nursing Homes EDAO: a complete solution for protecting the elderly in nursing homes

After the success of the first interconnected solution in 2016, a second establishment was equipped in early 2019.

"The combination of the two technologies improves the safety of residents and the working comfort of nursing staff," says Carole Zisa-Garat, CEO of Telegrafik.

How do these solutions protect nursing home residents?



The **VIVAGO** watch provides doctors and nurses with 24-hour traceability of all nursing home residents. In addition, this ergonomic and waterproof watch with its artificial intelligence module allows both manual calls by residents and automatic alarms in case of hazardous situations, as well as making it possible to permanently measure the resident's physiological activity and observe the quality of their sleep using a dashboard.

The Otono-me Nursing Homes EDAO solution is based on a video monitoring device installed in the residents' rooms. In the event of a potential risk, Telegrafik visually analyses the situation and nursing staff are then informed of the case requiring intervention. It is the only solution validated by a Hospital Programme for Clinical Research: "The device makes it possible to reduce the incidence of serious falls by 15% and reduce the incurred costs by 47.9%," says Prof. Dantoine of the Limoges University Hospital.
